

## **DORM ITEMS REQUIRED, ALLOWED AND NOT ALLOWED**

1. **Required:** linens (at least 2 sets), bedspread (twin size), mattress pad, toiletries, blanket, desk lamp, backpack for books, pillow, fan, alarm clock (non-phone), laundry bag, laundry detergent, towels and wash cloths, umbrella and/or rain coat, personal items (clothes, shoes, etc.).
2. **Optional:** computer with monitor/printer, iron and ironing board, fan, small floor rug (maximum 3'x5'), vacuum, refrigerator (must be compact, no more than 4.5 cubic feet, operate on regular 110 v. current, requiring *no more than 2 amps* of electricity), small office-type chair that adjusts in height for ease at working at the desk and computer, one small nightstand. A personal chair may be used with Dorm Director's approval. Bicycle, hair dryer, curling iron, radio/CD player (no large system), guitar, electric razor; foot locker (standard size, 30x16x12 inches).
3. **Not Allowed:** TV's, heaters, microwave, cooking appliances, halogen lamps, exterior antennae, water heaters, aerosol products (with the exception of shaving cream and approved medical products), colored lights, two-way communication apparatuses (e.g. CB transceiver), dart boards with pointed darts, knives or other sharp-edge tools. If in doubt, ask first.
4. Any furniture must be approved by the Dorm Director. Items not allowed will be taken and held for return to the student's home.

\*\*\***Translators:** (International students) Please note that only simple translators are acceptable in the dorm and in the classroom buildings during daily class times and study hall times. No devices that connect wirelessly to the internet, provide social media or electronic gaming are permitted as translators. If a student has a translator that has those capabilities it will be taken and kept by the dorm director until the end of the school year. Translators will not be allowed to be used during most examinations. If in doubt, ask first.

Suggested medications for boarding students to have on hand:

Acetaminophen (Tylenol) and Ibuprofen (Advil)  
Antihistamine (Benadryl and Benadryl cream)  
Nasal decongestant  
Expectorant  
Cough suppressant  
Cough drops  
Bismuth subsalicylate (Pepto-Bismol)  
Antibiotic ointment  
Antidiarrheal

### **SPECIAL NOTE:**

All telephones, computers, and other communication devices must be registered with the dorm director. They will be turned in to the dorm director by 10:30 p.m. each night before a regular school day – usually Sunday – Thursday nights and may be picked up at 6 a.m. They also should not be taken to the school buildings during school hours. On weekends (Friday and Saturday) they must be turned in by 12 midnight and may be picked up at 7 a.m. Violations will result in disciplinary action up to dismissal from the school.
